

Abstract Paper Collage

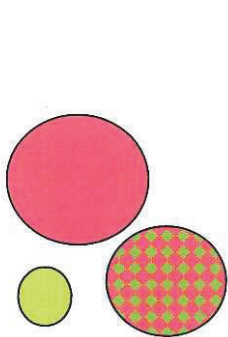
Materials:

- Variety of wrapping paper, colored construction paper, paper with texture, & patterned scrapbook paper if available
- Scissors
- YES paste
- Shallow paper bowls
- 11 x 14 in. white construction paper
- Wide & narrow black felt-tip markers

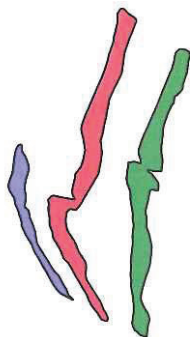
What to do:

1. Select a variety of samples and sizes of paper. (in both color and pattern)
2. Tear or cut three circular shapes out of any choice of papers. (fig.1)
3. Tear or cut three strips out of any choice of papers. (fig.2)
4. Use YES paste to adhere the circles *and* strips to the surface of the 11 x14 inch white paper.
5. Select three pieces of any colored paper, cut them into interesting shapes, and paste them in the corners of the white paper. (fig. 3)
6. Using both wide and narrow felt tip markers, add additional lines, shapes, words, and any other abstract drawings that you want on your collage. (fig.4)

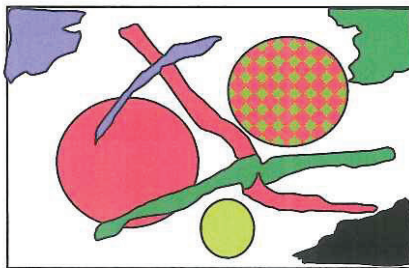
Do this while you listen to some interesting soundscape/music!



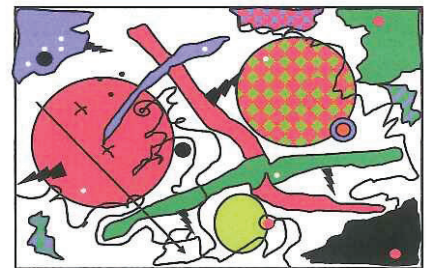
