



Draw a Red Winter Cardinal

Materials: white construction paper, lead pencils, cardinal drawing template, red, orange, black, green, brown and white oil pastels, blue water color, paint brushes

What to do:

1. Explain how to use the Red Winter Cardinal drawing template.
2. **Guided Drawing* means the teacher demonstrates and then children in turn draw to advance through each of the 6 boxes on the cardinal drawing template. Make sure students begin by drawing an image that will “bump the edges of the paper”.
3. When all 6 images have been drawn, instruct students to color the cardinal, branch, leaves, berries, and snow, (**DO NOT** color the sky) using oil pastels. They may add snowflakes or snow falling using white oil pastels.
4. Have students trace all lines of their drawing using black oil pastel.
5. Instruct students in the use of watercolor paints and have them paint the background sky, shades of blue.
6. Be sure to have students write their names on the back of their drawings.
