

Flower Collage

Materials needed:

12 x 24 white construction, thin strips of black construction paper, (approx.12 inch lengths) variety of colored card stock paper and/or colored scrap paper, water color paints, paint brushes, oil pastels, scissors, Elmer's Glue, pencils

What to do:

1. Use watercolor paint to create brightly colored background on white construction paper.

Allow paper to dry thoroughly.

- 2. While watercolor paint is drying, cut out flower shapes in different sizes and shapes. (see sample)
- 3. Color in designs on paper flower cut-outs using oil pastels.
- 4. When large construction paper is dry, glue black stems and branches to paper.
- 5. Next glue flower shapes to black branches.
- 6. Encourage students to add more designs to surface of paper using oil pastels.
- 7. Have students write their names on the back of their papers using pencils.
