



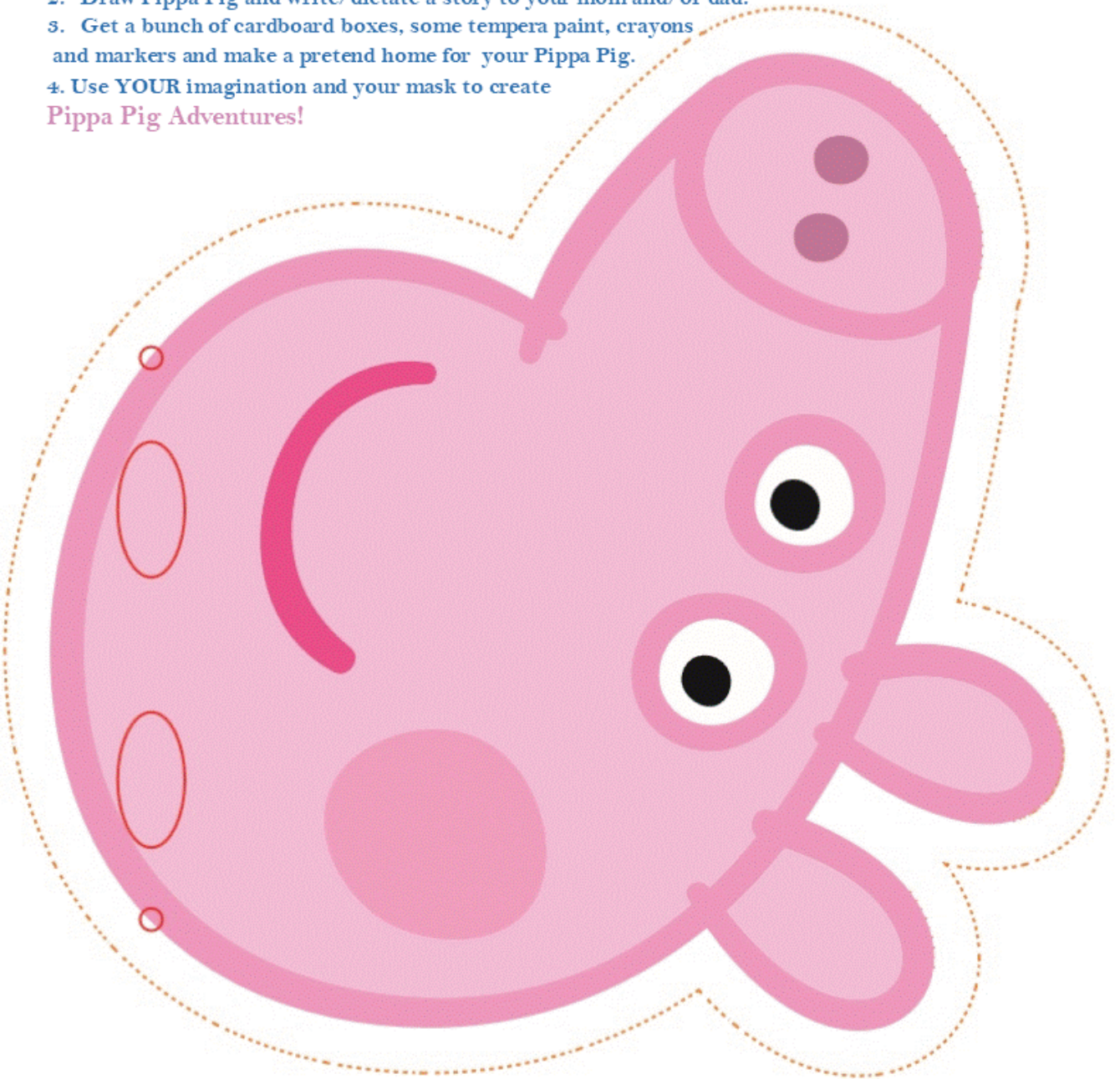
What to do:

2. Use scissors to cut out the mask on dotted lines. (be sure to cut out eye holes, so you can see)
3. Punch holes in sides of mask and attach string or elastic band. Place around head.
