

CCAA Coronavirus Update

CCAA is taking every precaution possible to ensure the health and safety of all of our students, instructors, staff and visitors to our facilities given the current public health concern. At this time, we do not have any knowledge of confirmed cases of COVID-19.

We want to let you know how we are handling this situation, and we are also posting the following message on our website:

The Coronavirus outbreak is an evolving situation which we are following closely. We are keeping in close communication with the Chester County Health Department, and we are taking the precautions and actions that the department has recommended.

Currently we are conducting business as usual and classes will be held. We ask all of our students, instructors, staff and visitors to our facilities to continue healthy practices that will minimize the possibility of the spread of the virus. If you are sick, please stay home.

In our facilities, everyone is encouraged to regularly wash their hands, use fist or elbow bumps for greetings, and to cough/sneeze into their elbows. We have hand sanitizing lotion, antibacterial wipes and antibacterial spray in each art studio and public areas.

If we receive calls from "at risk" individuals who aren't comfortable with attending a scheduled class, workshop or event, we will issue them a credit voucher for a future class.

In some instances, our outreach programs at area elementary schools and other after-school locations are being postponed to keep in line with specific school district concerns.
